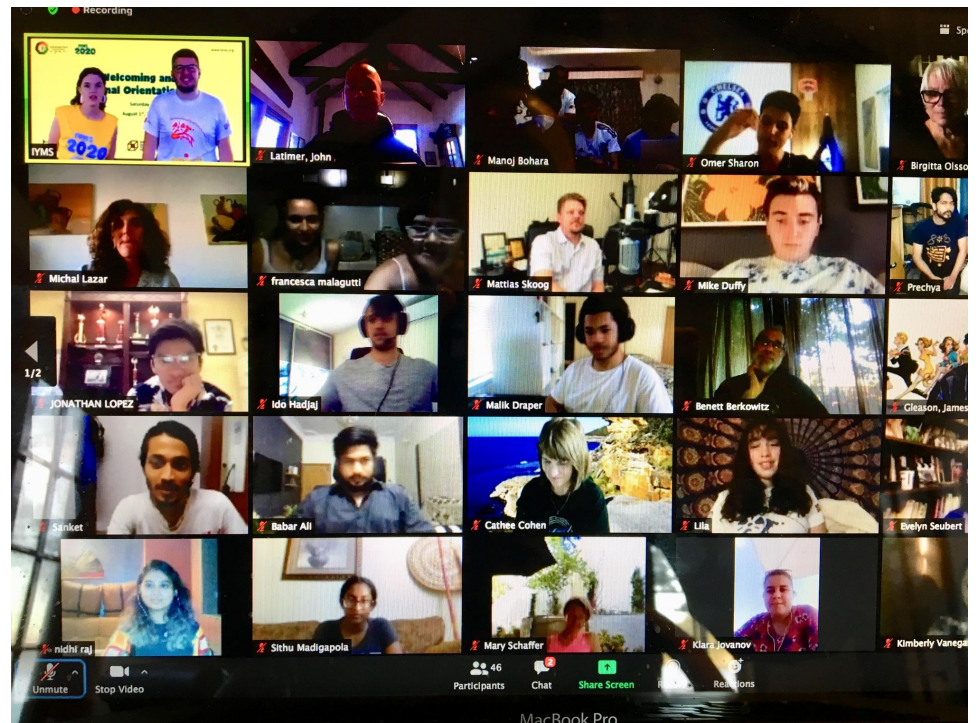

IYMS Croatia 2020!!

The International Youth Media Summit (IYMS) is an annual two-week event where delegates from all over the world meet for the opportunity to work beyond borders. They collaborate on media projects and motivate one another to take action and responsibility to inspire their generation and shape the world. This year the summit took place virtually and was organized by IYMS members in Karlovac, Croatia.

Delegates from all around the world came together on Zoom to explore the most urgent global issues. They created social action plans that are tightly connected to these issues: Discrimination, Environment, Health, Poverty, Violence, Women's Rights, and Youth Empowerment. Each issue group created a short public service announcement (PSA) video to impact social change on their issue. The 65 delegates from 23 countries, including five Cleveland media students, also participated in workshops and
