RULES	CONSEQUENCES*
Your current profession is "Student." If your behavior is unprofessional, there are consequences. GMS requires student <b>respectability, accountability &amp; responsibility.</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> infraction = private meeting w/ teacher team 2 <sup>nd</sup> = parent contact 3 <sup>rd</sup> = student, teacher, counselor and/or parent meeting 4 <sup>th</sup> = disciplinary action/deans' office
If you arrive at a job late, you get fired. <b>Tardies</b> are not acceptable in any GMS class.	Students are not allowed into classes without tardy slips. Students with 4 or more tardies per grading period will receive a "U" in cooperation.
If health requires an absence, you are required to get and make up missing <b>assignments.</b> Contact teachers via email for missing work.	Failure to complete missing assignments will result in a zero.
*Businesses run on <b>deadlines.</b> If you turn in work late, there are consequences.	*Assignments will be dropped one letter grade for all work turned in late.
Come to class <b>prepared.</b>	3 days unprepared will earn a "U" for work habits on the progress report.
<b>No unauthorized cell phones or electronic devices</b> used in class. They may only be used at the discretion of the teacher.	Electronics will be removed by the teacher and held or given to dean depending on the teacher's policy.
<b>Cheating or plagiarizing is not tolerated,</b> and assisting another student by letting them copy tests, homework or class work.	All students involved will receive a fail/zero on the assignment. Subsequent offences may result in expulsion from program.

*\* All rules are enforced at teachers' discretion based on individual circumstances.*
